About the program ...

The Kiwanis of Batesville and Key Club Members of Batesville High School are joining together to focus on the needs of the children in our community through their Kids & Us Program.

It is unique that we bring adult minds and young minds together to seek creative solutions to children's needs.

Why mix young students with adults in structuring the program?

The Key Club is an affiliate of the Kiwanis, and its members are above average students who strive to become leaders. These potential leaders are closer to the arena of students. The Key Club is a self-governed and self-sustaining group of volunteers. They want to help...and their assistance is greatly needed!

Why is the Kiwanis of Batesville involved in this project?

The Kiwanis of Batesville was formed over 30 years ago, and from the beginning were involved with kids through the soccer program, Kiwanis Student Leadership Academy, and Key Club.

Through our affiliation with the state, our local Kiwanis organization has also supported Riley Children's Hospital in Indianapolis.

Based on the propensity for local families to seek treatment for their children at Cincinnati Children's Hospital, in 2006 the organization, through its Kids & Us program, began supporting Cincinnati Children's Hospital through aid directed to the Children's Medical Clinic here in Batesville. This aid is administered locally by Dr. Scott Callahan at the Batesville clinic.

In 2010, the Batesville Kiwanis & Key Club Members are expanding their Kids & Us program through a tutoring partnership with area schools.

This partnership will focus on partnering the students with needs with adult volunteers to help them achieve a greater understanding of school subjects. The success of this partnership ultimately will be measured as progress in higher standardized test scores.

The goal for the tutoring component of the Kids & Us program is to involve the community in:

- ◇ **Helping children within the community to achieve a higher level of success as defined by the standardized test (ISTEP or Acuity) administered by the school they are enrolled in.**
- ◇ **Members plan to accomplish this by involving the community in a tutoring program to address student needs at the various grade levels to complement the education being provided by the school's educators.**

We look to the future as we further develop our Kids & Us program to carry out the mission of Kiwanis International ...

"Kiwanis is a global organization of volunteers dedicated to changing the world one child and one community at a time."

Our aim is to interview individuals, organizations, clergy, doctors, nurses, teachers, parents, grandparents ... anyone who is willing to talk about the communal needs of children.
